- Sacco and Vanzetti, 1921 (Fred Moore and Jeremiah McAnarney)
- O.J. Simpson, 1995 (Johnnie Cochran)

Using only the knowledge available to the viewer at the beginning of the film (prior to Andy's conviction), complete the following:

- A. Imagine you have been appointed as Andy's defense lawyer. What three pieces of advice would you give Andy for before and during the trial?
- B. As Andy's defense attorney, write a closing argument in which you argue before the jury as to why Andy should be found 'Not Guilty'.
- C. Imagine you are a member of the jury. Would you find Andy 'Guilty' or 'Not Guilty'? Why?
