Since mid-March, we have had to confront many challenges in operating a school productively and efficiently during a pandemic, as well as how to effectively deliver curriculum and instruction to our students. Many treasured events were cancelled, however, we were able to deliver a virtual **Baccalaureate Mass and** Ceremony to honor our seniors. Although this has been a most challenging time, we discovered through surveys and feedback that we were much more successful than most other schools.

As July approached, we assembled a Reopening Committee of teachers, administrators, and parents. The committee recommended a hybrid model of synchronous learning, with both in-person and remote learning. We created two cohorts that would rotate week to week, with one cohort learning in-person and the other remote synchronous learning. We were able to upgrade the technology in 30 classrooms, including installing new cameras, and integrating our smart boards and teacher's computers. These technology upgrades have



Saint Agnes School has had a strong start to the school year during these unprecedented times, with almost 100 new students joining our school. This enrollment increase led to the creation of four new classrooms. While most schools are either fully remote or operating on a hybrid plan, we made the decision early on that if we could do so safely, we wanted to be fully in person. We believe this is what's best for our students when it comes to learning as well as their social and emotional well-being. Although things certainly look a bit different, all of our students are learning all day every day.

The true heroes in all of this have been our teachers, who are not only working tirelessly to implement all of the health and safety measures throughout the day, but who are also teaching students at home whose families have chosen to learn remotely. This is no easy task, but they have risen to the challenge and for that we are most grateful.

This has been a year of technology upgrades. We now have 1:1 Chromebooks in Grades 3-8. Teachers are using Google Classroom and other Google tools to organize and allowed our teachers to deliver this first-class learning synchronous model more effectively, and differentiate us from other schools. To keep our entire community safe, we developed health and safety protocols and purchased necessary PPE and cleaning products.

Although these protocols have proven to be a significant investment, they have been effective in maintaining a safe and healthy learning environment. Unlike many schools in our area, our teachers are delivering curriculum and instruction with great success. We are very grateful for their hard work and commitment to their students as we continue to adapt to the changes brought about daily during this pandemic.

The entire Arlington Catholic community wishes to thank all of our alumni for their continued support, interest, and commitment to Arlington Catholic High School. We wish you and your family the best in the new year.
